Department of Cultural Arts a Division of Parks Recreation and Community Facilities invite you to participate in our eight week Collegiate Performing Arts Project.

Students must have written recommendation from their music professors and then complete an application for auditions. Only 10 students will be accepted for the Collegiate Performing Arts Project, students accepted into the project receive a scholarship valued at \$1,500.00. The program starts September 30th 2017 and runs through the final performance in January 2018.

The Collegiate Performing Arts Project is open to students currently enrolled in a four year College or University music program. This eight week intensive program is designed to give college students real world professional training, an opportunity to hone stage presence and develop a personal roadmap for the kind of artist they want to become. Students will be trained by dedicated professionals working in the industry. Participants will also learn all aspects of self promotions, marketing and management.

Participating students will have five opportunities to perform to a live audience on the Pine Camp Theater Stage. Two outstanding performers will be selected to go on to perform for an abundance of over 2,000 during the 2018 Dogwood Dell Festival of Arts.
